

## Benefits of Acetal Resin Partial Dentures

- Replaces missing teeth at an economical cost.
- Comfortable fit thanks to computer-aided design.
- Conforms well to the contour of your palate.
- Clasps are secure and kind to your teeth; Clasps are less visible because they are made from a tooth-colored flexible resin material.





## Considerations

- ✓ Removable appliance; Must be removed and cleaned after eating and before bedtime.
- Covers the palate, reducing your taste and temperature sensation.
- ✓ Average lifespan 5-10 years, depending on how you care for it.

You may be a candidate for other tooth replacement alternatives:



Cast Metal Partial Denture – a more rigid partial but with a very precise fit.



Dental Bridgework – fills in the missing teeth with crowns and simultaneously restores the surrounding natural teeth; not removable; care for it the same as your natural teeth.



Dental Implant with Crown – provides the most natural comfort; looks and functions like your own natural teeth in every way.
