

- ✓ Your same appliance is returned to you in "like new" condition. This means you save the expense and the learning curve associated with getting a new appliance.
- ✓ The investment is less expensive than a new appliance.
- Short-term option that buys you time to save up for eventual replacement in the near future.
- ✓ Stomadent has the ability to repair your appliance using the original material, if known, assuring a uniform appearance. This is particularly important if hypo-allergenic materials were used to construct the appliance originally.

## **Considerations**

- ✓ You will be without the appliance while it is being repaired. Do you have a spare?
- ✓ Have realistic expectations: If the appliance did not fit reasonably well or was severely worn before repairing, it will not be miraculously better after being repaired or relined.
- ✓ Minor breakage or changes in fit can often be corrected for a time with good success; repeated breakage or loose fit indicates a larger issue that often requires a new appliance be made to fit the current conditions of your mouth.
- ✓ If this is your second or third repair or reline to the same appliance, consider how much money you are spending each time versus the investment in a new appliance with a longer lifespan.

## Other alternatives to consider



For **mouthguard** wearers, your mouth changes over time. A mouthguard is designed to protect your teeth from subconsciously grinding or other external forces. If your mouthguard has broken, it may be time for a replacement. Stomadent offers a variety of mouthguard materials. Your dentist will select the material best suited for your specific application.



For **partial denture** wearers, you may be a candidate for a different type of removable partial, crown and bridgework, or dental implants with crowns – the most like your natural teeth.



For **complete denture** wearers, depending upon your health it may be possible to replace your denture with a denture supported entirely by dental implants. This allows the denture to snap into place for enhanced security and confidence – the nearest thing to your own natural teeth.
