Titanium Partial Denture

An unbeatable union of bio-compatible materials offering real comfort with a secure fit. Benefits of Titanium Partials

- Can be a more economical approach to replace missing teeth than crowns, bridges, or implants.
- Titanium is bio-compatible. The same material that is used to replace knees and hips.
- Virtually no one is allergic to titanium.
- ✓ Offers lightweight comfort that does not flex or move around while chewing, talking, laughing.
- Framework is "3-D printed" from a solid plate of titanium for an exact, precise fit.
- An ideal solution for patients who don't have any back teeth to help support their partial.

Considerations

- Because a titanium partial is a removable appliance, debris will get under it from time to time.
- Must be removed and cleaned after eating and removed before bedtime.
- Average lifespan 5 to 10 years, depending on how you care for the partial and how much your mouth changes as you age.



You may be a candidate for other prosthetic alternatives:



Flexible Partial Denture – a softer and more cushiony removable partial; doesn't fit as precisely as a titanium partial.



Dental Bridgework -

fills in the missing teeth with crowns for both the missing teeth and any surrounding natural teeth; not removable.



Dental Implants with Crowns -

the nearest thing to your natural teeth; bulky extra material is not necessary to support the artificial teeth.
